




DAY 1 | MON | TEL AVIV Arrival at Ben Gurion International Airport, where you will be met, assisted through baggage and customs, and escorted to your driver. You will then be transferred to your hotel in Tel Aviv for dinner and overnight. (D)

DAY 2 | TUE | TEL AVIV | JAFFA | TEL AVIV | Following a delicious breakfast, you will start your exploration with a visit to the "State of Mind" Innovation Center at the Tel Aviv Stock Exchange. Enjoy a walk around the Old Port City of Jaffa, the oldest seaport in the world. Next you will embark on a choice of two culinary tours that will introduce you to the very best of Tel Aviv's food scene: a Carmel Market tasting tour or a vegan culinary tour. Later, stroll along Rothschild Boulevard, home of The White City, Tel Aviv's most prominent collection of Bauhaus buildings. Revel in an evening at leisure to discover Tel Aviv at your own pace. (B)

DAY 3 | WED | TEL AVIV | CAESAREA | KIBBUTZ EXPERIENCE

I SHAVEI ZION After breakfast, depart Tel Aviv and head north to the ancient city of Caesarea, built by Herod the Great and once the administrative center of the Roman Empire for the Province of Judaea. The ancient port, the Roman hippodrome and amphitheater, and the impressive palace are among the many historical treasures. Next, visit Ein Shemer Kibbutz Museum, where you will experience a journey from the early days of the kibbutz communities to the present, and enjoy a delicious lunch in the Kibbutz dining hall. Continue with a tour of innovation at Kibbutz Magal and visit the Netafim greenhouse innovation center, a pioneering enterprise in the field of drip irrigation technology. Continue to your hotel in Shavei Zion for dinner and overnight. (B,L,D)

DAY 4 | THU | SHAVEI ZION | KATZRIN | SEA OF GALILEE | SAFED

I SHAVEI ZION Have breakfast at your hotel before driving along to the city of Katzrin, the "Capital of the Golan Heights." Stroll through a Talmudic village and get a sense of what it was like to live in the times of ancient Israel. Enjoy a tour and wine tasting at a local, family-owned boutique winery. Drive to the Sea of Galilee for a boat ride on the calm water. Continue to the mystical city of Tzfat (Safed), the birthplace of the ancient Jewish mystical text, the Kabbalah. Venture through the narrow, winding alleys, peer into the beautiful synagogues and browse the workshops and galleries in the flourishing artists' quarter. Return to Shavei Zion for dinner and overnight. (B,D)

DAY 5 | FRI | SHAVEI ZION | AKKO | HAIFA | JERUSALEM Enjoy a full Israeli breakfast at your hotel before exploring the ancient crusader port city of Akko, a fascinating UNESCO heritage site with new excavations that reveal what life was like 1000 years ago. See the port and fortifications that enabled the town to resist invasion by Napoleon. Take time to find some mementos at the Arab Bazaar, a true Middle Eastern shopping experience. Next, visit the amazing Bahai Gardens in Haifa with its staircase of 19 terraces extending all the way up Mount Carmel. On from there, drive to Jerusalem and check in to your hotel. In the evening, experience a special "Shabbat of a Lifetime" dinner in the home of a local Jewish family. Enjoy a traditional meal as you hear about and observe the customs of the Jewish Shabbat. (B,D)

DAY 6 | SAT | JERUSALEM | DEAD SEA | MASADA | ST. GEORGE |

JERUSALEM After breakfast this morning, set off towards the Dead Sea, the lowest spot on Earth at 1388 feet below sea level. Enroute, visit the legendary mountaintop plateau of Masada, the last stronghold of the Jewish Zealots in their struggle against the Romans in 73 CE. Ascending by cable car to the ancient fortress, explore the site with its synagogue and bathhouse. Afterwards, savor a leisurely afternoon at the Dead Sea shore with free time to cake yourself in mineral-rich mud and float in the buoyant waters. Next, drive to a lookout point for a view of Wadi Qelt and the cliff-hanging Monastery of St. George that was founded in the 5th Century and is still inhabited by Greek Orthodox monks. In the evening, enjoy a Sound and Light Show at the Tower of David, a creative depiction of the history of the city of Jerusalem (weather permitting). (B,L)

DAY 7 | SUN | JERUSALEM - OLD CITY Enjoy breakfast and then start the day's adventuring with an overview from the Mt. of Olives. Begin the exploration of the Old City of Jerusalem at the City of David

with its fascinating tunnels. See the newest excavations revealing Jerusalem during the time of the 1st Temple period. Walk through the Old City and visit some of its famous sites, including the Western Wall and the Cardo, an ancient commercial street where you can still shop today. Walk through the Arab Bazaar and experience traditional Middle Eastern life, with its rich colors and flavors, then stroll along part of the Via Dolorosa to the Church of the Holy Sepulcher. According to traditions dating back to the 4th century, the church is the site where Jesus of Nazareth was crucified, and also the site of Jesus's empty tomb, where he is said to have been buried and resurrected. This evening is yours at leisure to explore Jerusalem at your own pace. (B)

DAY 8 | MON | JERUSALEM - NEW CITY | BETHLEHEM |

JERUSALEM Have breakfast at your hotel and then head out to visit Yad Vashem, considered to be the world's primary Holocaust memorial and museum. Tour the new Holocaust History Museum and visit the exhibit at the Children's Pavilion, commemorating the death of over 1.5 million Jewish children. From Yad Vashem, move on to the Israel Museum. There you can see the Dead Sea Scrolls exhibition and view the famous Model of Jerusalem, depicting the city as it was in the 2nd Temple period. Continue to Bethlehem. See the Church of the Nativity and the remains of ancient Bethlehem (beneath the Greek Monastery), from the times of Christ. Return to Jerusalem and enjoy a special farewell dinner at a local restaurant. (B,D)

DAY 9 | TUE | JERUSALEM | TEL AVIV TO USA (OR EXTEND YOUR

STAY) Transfer from your hotel to Ben Gurion airport for your return flight home or continue your trip with an optional extension to Eilat and Petra.

- Explore ancient excavations in Caesarea and Megiddo, see the underground city and crypt in Acre, enjoy a boat ride on the Sea of Galilee, and stand on the Mount of Beatitudes where Jesus delivered the Sermon on the Mount
- Journey to Tabgha to commemorate the miracle of the loaves and the fishes
- Visit Cana and the wedding church where Jesus performed his first miracle
- Explore the Old City of Jerusalem visiting Mount Zion King David's Tomb, and the Room where the Last Supper took place. Visit the Christian & Jewish Quarters visiting the Church of the Holy Sepulchre, the Via Dolorosa & the Wailing (Western) Wall
- Marvel at the Qumran Caves where the Dead Sea Scrolls were found and see the artifacts at Israel Museum's Shrine of the Book
- •Take the once-in-a-lifetime opportunity to soak in the therapeutic, hyper-saline Dead Sea

DAY 1 SUN | TEL AVIV Arrive at Ben Gurion airport where you will be met and transferred to your hotel. Overnight in Tel Aviv. (D)

DAY 2 | MON | TEL AVIV | CAESAREA | MEGIDDO | HAIFA | ACRE | GALILEE | Depart Tel Aviv and drive along the coastal plain to Caesarea, once the Roman capital of the region; visit the excavations of the ancient city, the Roman theatre, and aqueduct. Proceed to Muhraka, the site of confrontation between Elijah and the prophets of Baal; enjoy the spectacular view of the Jezreel Valley and lower Galilee. Continue to Megiddo, identified as the site of Armageddon, and learn the impressive history of this battlefield as you visit the archaeological excavations. Next, it's on to Acre to visit the remarkable underground Crusader City and crypt; walk through the Old City, recognized by UNESCO as a world heritage site. Continue to Kinar Galilee Hotel for overnight. (B,D)

DAY 3 | TUE | GALILEE | TIBERIAS | CAPERNAUM | BANIAS | GALILEE After a short tour of Tiberias, enjoy a boat ride on the Sea of Galilee and visit the Yigal Alon center where the "Jesus boat," an ancient fishing boat from the 1st century, is displayed. Continue to Capernaum to visit the remains of the 2nd century synagogue. Stop at Tabgha, the site of the Miracle of the Loaves & Fishes, and visit the Church of the Multiplication with its 4th century mosaic floor. Proceed to the Mount of Beatitudes where Jesus delivered the Sermon on the Mount. Drive to the Banias Springs and tour the Golan Heights. Return to Galilee for overnight. (B,D)

DAY 4 | WED | GALILEE | CANA | NAZARETH | BEIT SHEAN | JERUSALEM Today, head out to Cana to visit the Wedding Church where Jesus performed his first miracle turning water into wine. Continue to Nazareth to visit the Church of the Annunciation, Joseph's workshop, and Mary's well. Proceed to Yardenit, the baptismal site on the Jordan River. Next, stop at Beit Shean to visit the newly excavated Roman city and amphitheater. Drive along the Jordan Valley to Jerusalem for overnight. (B,D)

DAY 5 | THU | JERUSALEM - OLD CITY After breakfast, drive to the Mount of Olives for a panoramic view of the city; visit the Church of All Nations, King David's Tomb, and the Room of the Last Supper on Mt. Zion. Enter the Old City and walk through the Cardo, the ancient Roman road. Visit the Jewish and Christian quarters and view the Temple Mount. Then take a stroll along the Via Dolorosa and drive to the oriental Bazaar to visit the Church of the Holy Sepulchre. Next, drive to the Garden Tomb and enjoy the beautiful gardens and peaceful ambiance. Overnight in Jerusalem. (B,D)

DAY 6 | FRI | JERUSALEM - NEW CITY & BETHLEHEM Today's adventure commences in Ein Karem with a visit to the Church of the Visitation. Proceed to Yad Vashem, Israel's official memorial to the Holocaust. Visit the Israel Museum and the Shrine of the Book, the place where the Dead Sea scrolls are housed, and the miniature model of Jerusalem as it was during the Second Temple period. Proceed to Bethlehem, birthplace of Jesus. Here you will explore Shepherds' Field and walk through Manger Square to visit the remarkable Church of the Nativity. Return to Jerusalem for your overnight stay. (B,D)





DAY 7 | SAT | JERUSALEM | QUMRAN | MASADA | DEAD SEA | JERUSALEM Mystery and history unfolds before you today starting with a drive through the Judean hills to the Qumran Caves, where the Dead Sea scrolls were found. Continue along the shores of the Dead Sea to Masada, the last stronghold of the Jews after the destruction of the Second Temple in 70 A.D. Ascend Masada by cable car and tour the mountain fortress built by King Herod. Here you will discover the remains of the walls, see the water cistern, and visit Herod's Palace before descending. Continue on to the Dead Sea, the lowest point on earth. Enjoy the opportunity to float in the unsinkable water and cover yourself with mineral rich mud, believed to have therapeutic effects. Return to Jerusalem for overnight. (B,D)

DAY 8 | SUN | JERUSALEM | TEL AVIV TO USA (OR EXTEND YOUR STAY) Transfer to Ben Gurion airport for your departure. (B)

- Visit the Western Wall (Kotel) and tour its tunnels
- •Stroll through the narrow alleyways of the Caro and Ari synagogues, visit the picturesque Artists' quarter in Safed, and take an adventure-filled Jeep tour to the foot of the Golan
- Discover the fascinating excavated remains from the Roman and Byzantine periods in Beit Shean
- In Jerusalem, visit the four Sepharadic Synagogues restored after 1967 in the Jewish quarter and marvel at the Dead Sea Scrolls on display at the Israel Museum's Shrine of the Book
- Float in the Dead Sea's hyper-saline waters and tour the rock fortress of Masada, Herod's great palace

DAY 1 | **FRI** | **TEL AVIV** Arrive at Ben Gurion airport where you will be met and transferred to your hotel. Overnight in Tel Aviv.

DAY 2 | SAT | TEL AVIV Full day at leisure and overnight in Tel Aviv. (B)

DAY 3 | SUN | TEL AVIV | CAESAREA | HAIFA | ACRE | ROSH HANIKRA | GALILEE Today, head north to Caesarea, once the Roman capital of the region. See the excavations of the Crusaders' city, the aqueduct and the amphitheater that has been restored as a concert venue. Proceed to Haifa to visit the Clandestine Immigration and Naval Museum ("Af al Pi Chen") and hear the story of the illegal emigrants to Israel at the time of the British mandate. Drive to Acre, whose Old City is recognized by UNESCO as a World Heritage Site. Continue on to Rosh Hanikra where you will descend by cable car into the underwater grottoes to admire the spectacular natural formation. Overnight at a Kibbutz guesthouse in Galilee. (B)

DAY 4 | MON | GALILEE | SAFED | GOLAN HEIGHTS | TEL-HAI | GALILEE Drive to Safed, one of the four holy cities in Israel and center of the Kabbalah movement. Visit the Caro and Ari synagogues and the picturesque Artists' quarter. Next, enjoy a Jeep tour to the foot of the Golan. Continue up the Golan Heights, stopping at Gadot overlook, a memorial for the fallen of the Golan located over former Syrian bunkers and view the monument built in honor of the Alexandroni Brigade. Take in the views over the city of Kuneitra and the Syrian territory. Drive to Tel-Hai; see the "Roaring Lion" monument and learn about the heroic battle of Josef Trumpeldor and his comrades in 1920. Meet with a Kibbutz member and learn about their unique lifestyle. Overnight at a Kibbutz guesthouse in Galilee. (B)

DAY 5 | TUE | GALILEE | TIBERIAS | BEIT SHEAN | BEIT ALPHA | GAN HASHLOSHA | JERUSALEM Drive to Tiberias to visit Rambam's grave. Continue through the Jordan Valley to Beit Shean, known as "Scythopolis," and see the fascinating excavated remains from the Roman and Byzantine periods. Stop at Beit Alpha to admire the beautiful mosaic floor of a synagogue discovered in 1929. Visit Gan Hashlosha national park and enjoy the warm spring water pools and waterfalls. Head on via the Jordan Valley to Jerusalem, stopping at Mount Scopus for a blessing as you enter the city. Overnight in Jerusalem. (B)

DAY 6 | WED | JERUSALEM Visit the Tomb of King David on Mt. Zion. Visit the four Sepharadic Synagogues in the Jewish quarter restored after the war of 1967. Visit the Western Wall (Kotel) and explore its tunnels. Next, visit the archaeological park at Davidson Center. Then, walk through the colorful local bazaar to visit the Tower of David museum presenting the history of Jerusalem and ancient remains of the city beginning with the First Temple period. Overnight in Jerusalem. (B)


DAY 7 ITHU I JERUSALEM Enjoy seeing the Bar-Mitzvah ceremonies at the Kotel. Drive through Mea Shearim, one of the oldest Jewish neighborhoods in Jerusalem and learn about the unique lifestyle of the ultra-orthodox communities. Head to Mount Herzl, the military cemetery, and on to the memorial to the Holocaust, Yad Vashem. Visit Ammunition Hill, a former Jordanian army stronghold, conquered by the Israeli army in the Six-Day War and converted into a national memorial site and museum. Drive by Israel's parliament, the Knesset, and see the Menorah with its biblical emblems. Next, visit Israel Museum's Shrine of the Book where the Dead Sea scrolls are housed, and see the Holy Land model, a miniature replica of Jerusalem as it was during the Second Temple period. Overnight in Jerusalem. (B)

DAY 8 | FRI | JERUSALEM | QUMRAN | MASADA | DEAD SEA | JERUSALEM Drive through the Judean desert to the Dead Sea, the lowest point on earth. Visit the Qumran Caves, where the Dead Sea scrolls were found. Continue to Masada and ascend by cable car, then tour the mountain fortress built by King Herod where the Zealots made their last stand against the Romans. Here you will see the remains of the walls, palaces, synagogue, and bathhouse before descending by cable car. Next, stop for lunch and experience the spa facilities in one of the leading hotels in the area and enjoy some time to float in the hyper-saline Dead Sea. Overnight in Jerusalem. (B,L)

DAY 9 | SAT | JERUSALEM Full day at leisure and overnight in Jerusalem. (B)

DAY 10 | SUN | JERUSALEM | TEL AVIV TO USA (OR EXTEND YOUR STAY) Transfer to Ben Gurion airport for departure. (B)
