DAY 1 | **THU | CAIRO** Arrive in the Land of the Pharaohs. Upon completion of immigration and customs formalities at Cairo International Airport, you will be met and transferred to your hotel.

DAY 2 | FRI | CAIRO Enjoy breakfast at your hotel before heading out to explore the Egyptian Museum of Antiquities. Then drive to Old Cairo, where early Judaism and Christianity flourished in Egypt. Here you will visit Al Moallaka Church (the Hanging Church), Saint Sergius Chuch, and Ben Ezra Synagogue. In the afternoon, a scenic drive will take you to explore the Pyramids and Sphinx of Giza, which have stood for the last 5000 years. (B,L)

DAY 3 | SAT | CAIRO | LUXOR After breakfast, transfer to Cairo Airport for your flight to Luxor, the ancient Egyptian city of Thebes. Here, you'll drive through lush farmlands to the Nile waterfront, where our newest deluxe 5-star Deluxe Nile Cruise Ship, the "H/S Nebu", awaits you. After a safety briefing, you'll enjoy lunch onboard the ship and settle into your spacious and stylish suite. This afternoon, visit the Valleys of the Kings and Queens, burial sites for many of the most powerful and successful pharaohs and high priests. You'll also visit the Temple of Hatshepsut and Medinet Habu Temple. (B,L,D)

DAY 4 | SUN | CAIRO | LUXOR Today, the H/S Nebu proudly sets sail. As Luxor dwindles into the distance, you'll join a procession of other stately cruise ships, amongst which the H/S Nebu surely takes the gold. This is the ideal opportunity to luxuriate in the peaceful rhythm of life on board the ship. In between sumptuous meals, cool off in the sparkling pool, sip cocktails in the shade on the deck, curl up with a good book, or capture everyday life along the Nile with your camera. (B,L,D)

DAY 5 | MON | EDFU | KOM OMBO | ASWAN After breakfast today, continue cruising up the Nile, arriving at the Temple of Kom Ombo in the late morning. This temple, unlike many others in Egypt, was dedicated to two gods – the Southern section is dedicated to the god of fertility Sobek, known as the crocodile-headed man, and the Northern section is dedicated to the falcon-headed god Horus. There is also a fascinating crocodile museum to visit here with many artifacts and mummified crocodiles on display. Return to the ship for lunch and sail onwards to the city of Aswan. (B,L,D)

DAY 6 | TUE | ASWAN | ABU SIMBEL | ASWAN Have a delicious breakfast onboard the H/S Nebu and then head out for more adventuring. Today, you'll get an idea of the vastness of Egypt's ancient dynasties as we fly 175 miles south from Aswan to the visit the great twin temples of Abu Simbel. Along with the Temple of Isis at Philae, they are part of the UNESCO World Heritage Site known collectively as the Nubian Monuments. Here, imposing 70-foot statues of Ramses II and Queen Nefertari overlook the Nile. After marveling at the architectural ingenuity of both the past and present, fly back to Aswan in time to enjoy lunch on board the ship. This afternoon, climb aboard a traditional felucca sailboat and sip sparkling wine in the glorious sunshine. (B,L,D)

DAY 7 | WED | ASWAN | KOM OMBO | EDFU Rise and shine in Aswan with a full breakfast onboard the H/S Nebu before heading out to explore the area beginning with the massive Aswan High Dam. You'll also take a short boat ride across the reservoir of the Aswan Low Dam to visit the elegant Temple of Philae, another of UNESCO's Nubian Monuments that had to be rescued from flooding. Philae was originally located near the First Cataract but was flooded after the construction of the Aswan Low Dam. From there, visit an ancient granite quarry, where you'll see the famed Unfinished Obelisk. After lunch on board the ship, start your relaxing return cruise past Kom Ombo towards Edfu. This evening, don traditional galabeyas for a fun party on board. Dressed in traditional garb, you'll be ready to dance like an Egyptian and to see a vibrant Oriental show with lively music that is sure to set the mood for a festive night like no other. (B,L,D)

DAY 8 | THU | EDFU | LUXOR After breakfast, horse-drawn carriages will await you along the waterfront at Edfu for the ride through this

small river city to the famously well-preserved temple of Horus. The largest temple dedicated to the falcon god, it is notable for the two stone falcons at its entrance and the huge relief figures on its façade. This afternoon, enjoy lunch on board the ship and more scenic Nile cruising as you return to Luxor. (B,L,D)

DAY 9 | FRI | LUXOR Power up with breakfast on board before exploring two of Egypt's most illustrious shrines: the Karnak and Luxor Temple complexes. You'll be awed by the Great Hypostyle Hall, where a monolithic forest of 134 huge columns is ranked in 16 rows. The largest are 33 feet around and soar to 80 feet in height. After dinner this evening, you'll be treated to a transfixing belly-dancing show on board the ship. Famed for its controlled and precise movements, Egyptian belly dancing is said to have originated in Cairo's nightclubs before graduating to create stars of the silver screen. (B,L,D)

DAY 10 | SAT | LUXOR | CAIRO After breakfast, it's time to bid farewell to the Nile and the crew of the H/S Nebu. Disembark and transfer to Luxor Airport for your flight back to Cairo. Upon arrival, you will be met and transferred to your hotel for overnight. (B)

DAY 11 | SUN | CAIRO TO USA (OR EXTEND YOUR STAY) After breakfast, transfer to Cairo International Airport for your departure flight. (B)



In the evening, enjoy an optional sound and light show at Karnak Temple. (B,L,D)

DAY 4 - SUN I LUXOR I ESNA I EDFU Early this morning, you will sail to Edfu via Esna, where you will pass through the Esna Lock. (B,L,D)

DAY 5 - MON I EDFU I KOM OMBO I ASWAN After breakfast, travel by horse-drawn carriage to the Temple of Horus, considered the bestpreserved ancient temple in Egypt and the second largest after the Temple of Karnak. Back onboard, sail to Kom Ombo and visit the Temple of Sobek and Haroeris before continuing to Aswan. (B,L,D)


DAY 6 - TUE I ASWAN This morning, visit the High Dam, the Granite Quarries and the temple of Isis at Philae. Later, sail on board a felucca, a traditional Egyptian sailboat, and view Kitchener's Island Botanical Garden and the Agha Khan Mausoleum. (B,L,D)



After lunch, sail to Kom Ombo, where you will visit the Ptolemaic Temple of Sobek and Haroeris before arriving in Edfu. (B,L,D)


DAY 4 - THU I EDFU I LUXOR Travel by horse-drawn carriage to the Temple of Horus, the falcon god. Dating from 237 B.C., it is considered the best preserved temple in Egypt and the second largest after the Temple of Karnak. Sail to Esna, passing through the Esna Lock, and continue sailing towards Luxor. (B,L,D)


DAY 5 - FRI I LUXOR Visit the West Bank necropolis including the Valley of the Kings, the Funerary Temple of Queen Hatshepsut at Deir El Bahari and the Colossi of Memnon. Enjoy an optional sound and light show at Karnak Temple this evening. (B,L,D)

DAY 6 - SAT I LUXOR I CAIRO After breakfast, visit Karnak and Luxor temples, a centuries old city of pylons, hypostyle halls, colossal statues, shrines and obelisks. Disembark and transfer to the airport for your afternoon flight to Cairo. Upon arrival in Cairo you will be met and escorted to your hotel. This evening enjoy an optional sound and light show at the Pyramid. (B)



DAY 2 | SUN | CAIRO After enjoying your breakfast, you will visit the Egyptian Museum of Antiquities to see the world's largest collection of Pharaonic artifacts. Next, it's on to the Saladin Citadel of Cairo, a medieval fortification located on Mokattam where you will enjoy a fresh breeze and grand views of the city. Today, it is a preserved historic site with mosques and museums. Then you will have your lunch at Naguib Mahfouz and continue your exploration, visiting Al Moallaka Church (Hanging Church), Ben Ezra Synagogue, and Khan El Khalili bazaar. (B,L)

DAY 3 I MON I CAIRO I LUXOR Transfer from your hotel to Cairo Airport for your morning flight to Luxor. Upon arrival you will be escorted to your Nile cruise ship. The Temple of Karnak, located on the East bank of the Nile, was built by several great kings of Egypt including King Ramses II, King Tutmosis III, and Queen Hatshepsut. It was dedicated to the triad of Thebes: god Amun Ra, goddess Mut, and god Khonsu. Luxor Temple was dedicated to the god Amun and contains structures from many periods, the earliest dating back to the 12th Dynasty. Back on board, enjoy afternoon tea and dinner. (B,L,D)

DAY 4 | TUE | LUXOR | ESNA Rise and shine with breakfast on board followed by a visit to the West Bank necropolis including the Valley of the Kings & Queens where magnificent tombs were carved into the desert rocks, decorated richly, and filled with treasures for the afterlife by generations of Pharaohs. Then visit the Funerary Temple of Queen Hatshepsut at Deir El Bahari who ruled Egypt for almost 20 years. She chose a very well protected location as it is surrounded by the mountains. Enjoy lunch on board, a sailing to Esna, and afternoon tea before the Captain's welcome cocktail party followed by dinner on board. (B,L,D)

DAY 5 | WED | ESNA | EDFU | KOM OMBO Sail to Edfu and have breakfast on board this morning. Today you will visit Edfu Temple. Totally submerged under the desert except for the very top of the pylon entrance, it is ancient Egypt's most complete and best preserved temple. A small amount of stone had been removed from the exposed part, but when excavated it was found to be in near perfect condition. Enjoy lunch on board and afternoon tea before visiting the temple of Kom Ombo, uniquely dedicated to two gods. The southern half of the temple was dedicated to the crocodile god Sobek, while the northern part of the temple was dedicated to the falcon god Haroeris. Later, join in the Galabeya party and dinner on board. (B,L,D)

DAY 6 | THU | KOM OMBO | ASWAN Sail to Aswan and enjoy breakfast on board followed by a visit to the world famous High Dam, an engineering miracle when it was built in the 1960s. The dam was

completed in 1971 and the huge reservoir behind it, named for President Nasser, was finished filling in 1979. The High Dam provided about half of the electricity production in Egypt, bringing power to most of Egypt's villages for the first time. By regulating the flow of the river, the dam also increased the cultivatable land in Egypt by around 30 percent and allowed development in new areas that were previously inundated annually when the river flooded. Later, visit the Granite Quarries and see the unfinished obelisk; discover Philae Temple that rose to prominence during the Ptolomaic Dynasty as the center of the cult of the goddess Isis. Have lunch on board, followed by a sailing along the Nile by felucca around Kitchener's Island and Agha Khan Mausoleum. Sip on afternoon tea, and then enjoy the Nubian Folkloric show followed by dinner on board. (B,L,D)

DAY 7 | FRI | ASWAN | CAIRO Delight in breakfast on board then transfer from your Nile Cruiser to Aswan Airport for your morning flight to Cairo. See the Sphinx, with the head of a man and the body of a lion. Enjoy lunch at Mena House and continue to Sakkara, you will see the famous Step Pyramid. At the site of Memphis, you will see the ancient capital that once stood as a flourishing metropolis during the time of the Pharaohs. (B,L)

Walk through the Siq, a narrow and winding fissure between the cliffs, to reach the Treasury, the Roman Theater, the Courts, Qasr Bint Pharaoun, the Temple of the Winged Lion and other breathtaking monuments. Dinner and overnight at Petra Hotel. (B,D)



Alamein from Alexandria

Journey along to Wadi El-Natrun for a full day visit to Alamein. The German Shrine, an ossuary containing the remains of 4,213 German soldiers who fell during the battle of El Alamein, was built in the style of a medieval fortress and is situated beside the Italian cemetery. Next, take a short drive to Qaitbey, a citadel on the outskirts of the City. Built around 1479 and situated next to the Nile river, it guarded the city from attacks by Mediterranean invaders. Take some time to climb to the top of the citadel along the fortified walls. Afterwards, head back towards Alexandria with a stop for lunch and time to relax before returning to your hotel.



Half-Day Montazah Palace and Gardens

Embark on a fascinating half day tour from Alexandria to visit Monatazah Palace Gardens and see the former summer residence of King Farouk, Egypt's last king. Overlooking Al Montaza Gulf, The Montaza Gardens Complex was originally built in 1892 by the last Khedive of Egypt and Sudan, Abbas Helmy II. The royal family continued taking care of the Montazah complex until the reign of the last king of Egypt, Farouk I. This striking palace, located on Egypt's northern coast, exudes a mix of Moorish-style with a touch of Florentine design. Venture along to enjoy the delightful gardens, dazzling with vibrant colors, and take in the beautiful architectural facades of the Montazah Palace before driving along the Corniche to see the whole city from Stanley Bridge, an iconic landmark of modern Alexandria. ACE- Animal Care in Egypt

If you are an animal lover, this cherished excursion is perfect for you. Take time to explore Animal Care in Egypt (ACE), a visitor center where guests can see trained animal care teams at work. The ACE is a Veterinary Hospital working to UK standards that gives free veterinary care and treatment to neglected and abused animals. ACE also runs an educational program where local school children come to learn how to treat animals kindly and respectfully. ACE helps animals in Luxor by prevention, maintenance treatments, and education. Hours of operation are Saturday – Thursday from 9am to 5pm.



Howard Carter House

It's no secret that famed British Archaeologist and Egyptologist Howard Carter left his mark forever in Luxor. Come visit the home of Carter, who together with his archeological dig team, discovered the most famous site known to the ancient Egyptian world, that of the golden Pharaonic burial mask and intact Tomb of King Tutankhamun. Step back in time as you stroll through his home on this half day tour.



Mummification Museum

The art of mummification takes center stage today with an enchanting opportunity to explore the Mummification Museum in Luxor City. Egyptian mummification was a funerary process in which the organs of the deceased were removed from the body and the body was wrapped in strips of linen cloth. While the process was performed to "ease the path to the afterlife" for ancient Egyptians, it also had the secondary effect of preserving the dead with astonishing success, enabling today's scientists and historians to discern an immense amount of information and detail about the lives of these ancient humans. At the Mummification Museum in Luxor City, visitors can see both human and animal mummies, tools used in the process of mummifying, some ornately painted coffins, and even some of the items commonly buried with the mummified that were considered crucial to the mummy's journey to the afterlife.



Hot Air Balloon Ride

After an early morning pickup from your Luxor hotel or cruise ship, transfer to the hot air balloon launch site on the west bank of the Nile River. On arrival, enjoy some light pre-flight snack and refreshments, and meet your expert pilot and ground crew. After a comprehensive safety briefing, step into the balloon's sturdy basket with your pilot and fellow passengers. Then, feel your adrenaline surge as the brightly colored balloon rises into the still-dark sky for your approximate 30 to 45-minute flight. Soak up the jaw-dropping, aerial views just as the sun peers over the east bank of the Nile River. Look to the east to see the pillars of Karnak Temple greet the morning sun and then turn west to admire Queen Hatshepsut's Temple cast in the glow of dawn. View the Colossi of Memnon rising from the nearby then take in the Valley of the Queens nestled in the craggy mountains. Float over the Ramesseum, the impressive funerary temple of Pharaoh Ramses II, and gaze down at its pylons, statues, and courtyards. After a safe touchdown, head back to Luxor where your experience ends with a drop-off at your hotel or ship in time for breakfast and your morning tour departures.

Nubian Museum

Get ready to be mesmerized by history today at Aswan's Nubian Museum, displaying some five thousand artifacts that showcase the history and culture of the Nubians. At the entrance to the main hall, a scale model of the Nile valley shows the magnitude of the Nilotic civilization and their architectural achievements. The exhibits lead you from the kingdoms of Kush and Meroe into Christian and Islamic eras, on to the inundation of Nubia by Lake Nasser, and along to the salvage of its ancient monuments. Among the highlights are a quartzite statue of a Kushite priest of Amun, an eight-meter-high Ramses II, horse-armor from the Ballana tombs, and frescoes from the Coptic churches of Nubia. There are also life-size models of traditional Nubian houses and photographs of the mud-brick fortress, churches, and cemeteries that were abandoned to the rising waters of Lake Nasser as the temples were moved to higher land. Across the complex there are other monuments and exhibits, including the mausoleum of 77 wali (sheikhs).


