

DAY 2 | SAT | POLIEGOS | FOLEGANDROS Morning arrival in Poliegos, a very small island known for its amazing beaches. Morning swim stop followed by a BBQ on deck. - Travel to Greece on a voyage through history dedicated to the Golden Age of Greek civilization and beyond
- Enjoy the splendid opportunity to visit off-the-beaten-path towns and ports including: Palaia Epidauros, Nafplion, Mycenae, Gythion, Pylos, Olympia, Delphi, and more.
- Experience a lifetime moment as you cross the engineering feat that is the Corinth Canal, cut through solid rock in the 1880's to join the Ionian Sea with the Aegean Sea.
- Learn about Byzantine Art and the history of each place to be visited with featured onboard lectures.
- Journey to coastal towns in the Peloponnese peninsula and trace the paths of classical antiquity and the Roman conquest, ending with the transition to the Christian empire of Byzantium

DAY 1 | FRI | ATHENS | PALAIA EPIDAUROS Embarkation at Marina Zea in Athens between 2:00 and 3:00pm. Enjoy a welcome drink and meet your crew and fellow passengers. Sail for Palaia Epidauros. Evening arrival and dinner on board. (D)

DAY 2 | SAT | PALAIA EPIDAUROS | NAFPLION Leave the ship early in the morning to drive to Ancient Epidauros for an optional excursion. Epidauros was known throughout the Greek world as a healing sanctuary. It was reputed to be the birthplace of Apollo's son Asclepius - and for its theater, which is once again in use today. The sanctuary was looted by the Roman general Sulla by pirates and later by Goths in 395 A.D. and very little remains of it today. The prosperity brought by the Asclepieion enabled the residents of Epidauros to construct civic monuments, including a huge theater (approximately 300 B.C.) renowned for its symmetry and beauty. Lunch on the ship and afternoon sailing to Nafplion. Overnight at port. (B,L,D)

DAY 3 | SUN | NAFPLION | MONEMVASIA After a short walking tour of Nafplion, drive through the colorful city and the beautiful countryside of Argolis towards Mycenae for an optional excursion. The importance of the city, which Homer called "rich in gold", began in 1650 B.C and ceased around 1100 B.C with the fall of the civilization to which it gives name. Visit the remains of the ancient glorious city including the Lion's Gate, the Palace, the so-called Agamemnon Tomb and the museum. Lunch on the ship and afternoon sailing to Monemvasia. Time at leisure to explore. Overnight sailing to Gythion. (B,L,D)

DAY 4 | MON | GYTHION Early morning arrival to Gythion. Optional excursion to Mani peninsula and Cape Tenaro plus the spectacular Dirou Caves with their stalactites and stalagmites. Ancient Gythion was inhabited during prehistoric times and later the Spartans used it as a port. Leaving Gythion, cross the scenic Mani Peninsula to reach Diros and visit the spectacular caves, discovered around the 60s, and perhaps among the most important natural sites of Greece. After visiting the cave, drive to nearby Areopolis for a short stroll through the town. Mani is at the tip of the Peloponnese, a distinctive area unlike any other area in Greece. Overnight at sea to Pylos. (B,L,D)

DAY 5 | TUE | PYLOS Pylos is a picture-perfect seaside town on the southwest corner of the Peloponnese. In 1827, a fleet of Venetians and other city states defeated an Ottoman fleet in one of the most important naval battles in history. This defeat led to the independence of Greece, which occurred in 1829. During an optional excursion and after stopping to admire the scenery, continue up the road to Nestor's Palace. The remains of the prehistoric Palace occupy a scenic hilltop setting north of Pylos. Highlights include the well-preserved royal apartments and a bathtub that archaeologists have speculated belonged to the old king himself. The palace, with its

central courtyard, was originally two stories high and richly decorated with frescoes. Following, make the short trip to the town of Hora where a superb archaeological museum holds thousands of artifacts recovered from the site. Overnight sailing to Katakolon. (B,L,D)

DAY 6 | WED | KATAKOLON | ITEA Early morning arrival in Katakolon. Disembark the ship around 7:00am in the port town of Katakolon. Take an optional excursion by bus to Olympia, one of the most famous and important sites in the ancient world. Revered as the birthplace of the Olympic Games, it was also the greatest Pan-Hellenic sanctuary for the worship of Zeus. Olympia persisted well into Roman times until its demise in the 3rd century A.D. when fires, earthquakes and invading tribes from the north left the ancient site in ruins. The most thrilling site at Olympia is the stadium, which looks much like it did more than 2,000 years ago. You will also explore the Temple of Hera, the magnificent temple of Zeus the Philippeion - lodging place for the athletes who participated in the games. Following lunch, visit the museum of the History of the Olympic Games of Antiquity to view statuary and a host of artifacts specifically related to the ancient Olympic Games. After time at leisure, travel over land to Patras on the north coast of the peninsula to re-board the ship and depart for Itea in the Gulf of Corinth. Overnight in Itea. (B,L,D)

DAY 7 | THU | ITEA | ATHENS Morning optional excursion to Delphi, one of the most revered sites from the ancient world. Disembark the ship early this morning and proceed to the ruins complex. In its prime, Delphi was revered for its wealth and reputation, attributes which grew from the site's location as hosting the most important oracle in the classical world. The oracle had the ability to prophesize the future and give advice. Visitors from across the Greek world traveled here to consult with the oracle, and responded by offering thanks in the form of treasure. Return to the ship and cross the Corinth Canal. Later in the evening, enjoy a Captain's Farewell Dinner then sail to Marina Zea for overnight. (B,L,D)

DAY 8 | FRI | ATHENS Disembarkation after breakfast. (B)

Here, stroll with your guide through the quaint narrow streets, passing by the Church of St Lawrence, the Inquisitor's Palace, and several palaces built during the time of the Knights. From Vittoriosa, you will venture further back in history with a visit to Hagar Qim Temples, a magnificent temple site built over 7000 years ago. Depart to Burgos, the capital of the Castilla & Leon Community, land of kings and the birth city of the famous medieval Spanish hero 'El Cid'. Here we will pay a visit to one of the world's best Gothic Cathedrals, built in 1221, the Arch of Santa María, Casa del Cordón, a beautiful Renaissance Palace from the 16th century, before continuing to Santo Domingo de la Calzada. The Parador, attached to the Cathedral, is housed in a 12th Century Hospital formerly used to shelter the pilgrims on the Road to Santiago. (B)

DAY 4 | WED | SANTO DOMINGO DE LA CALZADA | RIOJA MAIN VILLAGES | SANTO DOMINGO DE LA CALZADA

We will depart for the Rioja Wine route, visiting the most important villages, such as Haro, El Ciego, Cenicero...where the most important wineries of La Rioja are located. Today we will visit the Winery of Ysios, whose main building has been designed by Santiago Calatrava, the famous Spanish architect, and has made it an icon of the art/design wineries. After breakfast, depart for Olite. En-route, pay a visit to The Wine Culture Museum, located in Dinastía Vivanco Cellars, in the Old village of Briones with permanent & temporary expositions. A visit to the Museum & Cellars ends with a Wine Tasting and explanation given by a sommelier. Continue to LaGuardia, probably the most preserved medieval village in la Rioja. You can enjoy some free time to walk along the ancient wall, have a coffee outside in the plaza, take in the views, and see its collection of splendid country churches. Lunch at your own leisure. Continue to Logroño, the capital of La Rioja Region. Although it is renowned for wine, this capital has remains from the 3rd century B.C. with a celtiberic setting at the Catabria Mountain, overlooking the city. Later, drive towards Olite for your overnight stay. This Parador in Olite is partially set into the Old Palace from 15th Century, where you can find beautiful hidden corners of Medieval archeries, glaziers, etc. (B)

DAY 6 | FRI | OLITE | CARIÑENA | SIGÜENZA Today visit Olite, an ancient village where you will go back in time. Don't miss the French Gothic Castle-Palace, home of the Kings of Navarra during centuries. Stroll along its narrow streets, manor stone houses with Coat of Arms by the wooden doors, medieval galleries and, of course, the very well preserved Roman walls. The Mediterranean climate has also made Olite one of the capitals of Rioja Wine. After this visit, continue to Cariñena for a visit & tasting at the Cellars Señorío de Ayles. Lunch at your own leisure then continue towards Sigüenza. Arrival for check-in & overnight at the Parador, a gorgeous 12th Century Medieval Castle, which is the symbol of the city. (B)

DAY 7 | SAT | SIGÜENZA | ALCALÁ DE HENARES | MADRID Today you will explore the village of Sigüenza with its storied history, winding paths of medieval buildings, its distinguished cathedral, 16th Century Plaza Mayor, and its 12th Century Castle turned Parador. 

Continue to Sagres, a fishing port, for a visit to the fortress where the “navigation school” is forever linked with Prince Henry the Navigator during the first days of Atlantic navigation and the discovery of the African coast. Proceed along to the cliffs to Cabo Sao Vicente, the most southwestern point in Europe. This afternoon, take time to savor the flavors of Lagos, a cosmopolitan town with a marina and fishing port where you can taste delicious Algarve dishes, such as fish and shellfish cooked in a copper pan (cataplana) or fine sweets, such as the famous marzipan almond and fig cakes. Overnight in Lagos. (B)

DAY 5 | LAGOS | SETUBAL | SERRA DA ARRABIDA | LISBON This morning, take a last look at the water while traveling along the coast as you say farewell to the Algarve. The return trip to Lisbon will take you by the city of Setubal, a major port and industrial center on the north bank of the Sado estuary. Next, travel the scenic route over the Arrabida Mountain Range, an area preserved as a Natural Park with amazing scenery and unique vegetation at the gates of Lisbon. Crossing the bridge over the Tagus River, we arrive in Lisbon. (B)

DAY 3 | EVORA | OBIDOS | BATALHA | COIMBRA After breakfast, head north to Coimbra. On our way, we stop in the charming village of Obidos and in Batalha for a visit of its imposing 14th century Monastery. Coimbra, known as Portugal's most romantic city, was the inspiration for the song "April in Portugal." On the weather-washed right bank of the muddy Mondego, this city of medieval churches is also the educational center of the country, and is at its best when the university is in session and the city radiates youthful energy. Overnight in Coimbra. (B)

DAY 4 | COIMBRA | BAIRRADA AND DÃO | PORTO After breakfast at the hotel, we drive to the fertile wine growing areas of Dão and Bairrada. In the western part of the Beiras, between the mountainous Dão region and the surf-washed Atlantic beaches, Bairrada has a mild, maritime climate with abundant rainfall. Although much of the Bairrada region is hilly, the majority of the vineyards are on flatter land. Continue to the Dão region. This area is a fine example of the changes that are driving the rapid improvement in Portuguese wines. Once home to mostly large cooperative wineries that churned out wine en masse, it's now blossoming into a premier wine region with several small, quality minded producers. Overnight in Porto. (B)

DAY 5 | PORTO Start your day with an orientation tour of Porto, Portugal's second largest city. Sitting pretty among the hilly landscape at the mouth of the Douro River, Porto welcomes visitors looking for history, culture and a good glass of port wine. Porto's historic center is the Ribeira district, a UNESCO World Heritage Site. See its narrow, cobbled streets, pause for a cup of coffee and "pastel de nata" at one of many inviting cafes. Walk across the 19th century Ponte de Dom Luis Bridge to visit Porto's other half - the port-soaked Vila Nova de Gaia. Here you can tour one of the many ancient port wine cellars, learn about the beverage's history and sample some of the rich red liquid for yourself. Overnight in Porto. (B)

DAY 6 | PORTO | DOURO VALLEY | PORTO Today we drive to the Douro Valley, a UNESCO World Heritage Site. The valley is spectacularly beautiful with the hills falling steeply down to the water's edge becoming more and more sparsely populated and wild the further inland one travels, with more of the land being given over to terraces of vines and, to a lesser extent, olive groves. 





- Cancellations between 59 and 46 days of departure date: The cancellation penalty is 25% of the cost of the land package. - Cancellations 14 days or less prior to departure date: The cancellation penalty is 100% of the cost of the land package. Booking deposits, in addition to any and all other expenses already incurred on behalf of the Passenger, are non-refundable. Such other expenses include, but are not limited to, airline tickets, non-refundable deposits, full payments tendered for hotel accommodations, and transportation services.

- No refunds will be made on any unused portion/services of any tour package.

Rail Tickets: Rail Tickets and Rail Passes (Electronic and paper tickets) are non-transferable, and cannot be exchanged without penalties once issued, nor replaced if lost.

Airfares: Contracted airfare as well as published airfare cancellation fees vary according to the airline/carrier. Fees will be communicated at time of cancellation.

Cruises: Requirements for deposits and cancellations will be communicated at the time of booking and/or cancellation accordingly.

Villas/Castles & Home Rentals: Requirements for deposits and cancellations will be communicated at the time of booking and/or cancellation accordingly.

3.F. CHANGE FEES: A \$50 per person fee applies for each change on deposited bookings up to full payment due date.

4. INVOICING You are responsible for verifying everything on the provided invoice is accurate complete, and information matches the traveler's documentation (passport) Central Holidays cannot accept financial responsibility or any other responsibility for non-reported inconsistencies and errors. Read (3.F).

5. TRAVEL/ TOUR SERVICES

5.A. AIRFARES: Central Holidays offers the following airfares:

- **CONTRACTED AIRFARES**

Contracted Airfares allow flexibility if You want to make changes to your vacation schedule prior to ticketing. Once ticketed, any

changes or cancellations are subject to penalties which vary per airline carrier. Penalties of up to 100% of the airfare may apply. Other fare restrictions may apply.

- **PUBLISHED AIRFARE**

Published airfares may offer additional airline options, nonetheless, they carry more restrictions. Full payment plus a non-refundable service fee is required. Once booked, published airfare is non-changeable, non-refundable after 24 hours from purchase and subject to fare increase and carriers' terms and conditions of purchase. No airfares, taxes and fuel surcharges are confirmed/ guaranteed until final payment is received. Any variations will be the passenger's responsibility until final payment is received. It is the passenger's responsibility to reconfirm all flights 72 hours before flight date/time. Should the airline request, for any reason whatsoever, an unexpected issuance of air tickets, they must be immediately paid in full, regardless of any previous notification to passenger.

Contracted airfare as well as published airfare change and cancellation fees vary according to each airline and are based on the carriers' terms and conditions of purchase. Fees will be communicated at the time of cancellation. Once the airline ticket has been issued, its cancellation penalty amount will be in addition to the LAND and/or LAND & CRUISE cancellation fees. (3.E)

NOTE: In all instances, regardless of the airfare used, "NO SHOWS" are non-refundable.

LIMITATION OF RESPONSIBILITY:

Central Holidays is not responsible for the cancellation fees of airline tickets issued by companies other than ourselves, even if we cancel a departure for any reason whatsoever, including a cancellation of a pledged departure for lack of participation or force majeure. Due to the fluctuating restrictions, protocols and regulations imposed by local governments and international destinations to curb the spread of the global COVID-19 pandemic, Travel verification processes and requirements are the sole responsibility of the Passenger. Local, government and other information resources are readily available and constantly updated online.

5.G. ESCORTED TOURS: Our website and/or brochure display our preferred hotels' selection. However, hotels are not guaranteed. Central Holidays reserves the right to substitute hotels with hotels other than those listed on the itinerary pages. No refunds are provided for hotel changes and full cancellation penalties, as noted above, apply.

Non-Operation of Escorted Tour - Dates of pledged departures are based on historical seasonal data. Cancellation of any tour for any reason will be advised at least 45 days prior to the tour's departure. Central Holidays will offer alternate departures or other type of travel arrangements including private services. If Passengers do not accept the alternate offers, Central Holidays will offer a future Travel Credit. Central Holidays is not responsible for any costs related to the issuance and/or cancellation of airline tickets which are not purchased directly from Central Holidays including but not limited to airline tickets, travel insurance or visa fees. Voluntary cancellations due to political instability, acts of terrorism, government intervention or U.S. State Department warnings will be subject to the above terms.

FUTURE TRAVEL CREDITS: Future Travel Credit ("FTC") is valid for 18 months, unless Central Holidays extends the expiration period in writing. The FTC is transferable to friends and family with written authorization from the FTC holder. The FTC may be redeemed by booking travel to any of our destinations through any of our brands (Journeys and Group Travel Experiences). The FTC cannot be refunded and has no cash value. All redeemed FTC reservations are subject to all of Central Holidays' Terms and Conditions. Restrictions may apply for group travel.

TOUR SERVICES: At times, last minute changes on an itinerary or services are necessary for reasons (weather, strikes, acts of God or government, acts of terrorism or the threat thereof, force majeure, war, quarantine, epidemics or the threat thereof, criminal activity, etc.) beyond Central Holidays' control. Central Holidays is not responsible for any additional costs related to these changes.

TOUR PARTICIPANTS (Escorted Tours): The age limit on ESCORTED TOURS is 8 years old.

5.I. TRANSFERS: Except where indicated, transfers to/from arrival and departure city airports ARE NOT INCLUDED, but can be provided for a fee. Travel Agents/Passengers are fully responsible to communicate in writing any flight, time & routing schedule change. A change fee will be applied for each schedule change. When included, transfers for Escorted Tours have no cash value. **NOTE:** Transfers to/from Rail Stations are not included, unless otherwise indicated. No refunds apply for any unused transfers.

5.J. MEALS: Meals are included as indicated under "Included Features" of each program and have no cash value. No refunds apply for any unused meals.

6. TRAVEL INFO & RESTRICTIONS

6.A. AIR ARRANGEMENTS: SEAT ASSIGNMENT AND SPECIAL REQUESTS: for meal requirements, special services and frequent flyer miles (subject to specific airlines rules/ availability), are at the sole discretion of the airline.

Complaints regarding a hotel's standards or amenities should be addressed directly with the hotel's management (Point of Service). Airline flight cancellations and delays for any reason are not the responsibility of Central Holidays. The refund/ reservation requirement for airlines does not apply to tickets booked through third party agents.

No person, other than an authorized representative of Central Holidays is authorized, by a document in writing, to vary, add or waive any term or condition in this brochure, including any term or condition set forth in the preceding provisions.

8.d. ARBITRATION:

Any controversy or claim arising out of or relating in any way to these Terms and Conditions, to this Tour Agreement, to these brochures, or any other information relating in any way to the trip, or to the trip itself shall be resolved exclusively by binding arbitration in Moonachie, New Jersey in accordance with the commercial rules of the American Arbitration Association then existent. In any such arbitration the substantive (but not procedural) law of New Jersey will apply. The arbitrator and not any federal, state, or local court or agency shall have exclusive authority to resolve any dispute relating to the interpretation, applicability, enforceability, or formation of this contract, including but not limited to any claim that all or any part of this contract is void or voidable.
